### INSTRUCTIONS

1. Pick your oranges and arrange them by size. We'll be putting the biggest on the bottom, the medium one in the middle, and the smallest on top!
2. Use the plastic knife to spread a bit of icing over the bottom of your plate. Place the biggest orange on the plate.
3. Using the knife, spread icing on top of the biggest orange. Place the medium orange on top of it.
4. Using the knife, spread icing on top of the medium orange. Place the smallest orange on top of it.
5. Use scissors to cut a small, rectangular piece of cardboard. This will be the base of your snowman's hat!
6. Use the plastic knife to spread icing on top of the smallest orange. Place the rectangular piece of cardboard on top of it.
7. Using the plastic knife, spread icing on top of the cardboard. Place one of the lifesaver mints on top of it. Repeat this process with the other two lifesaver mints so your hat is three mints high!
8. Break off three small pieces of a candy cane. Use the plastic knife to apply icing to the sides of your middle orange. Stick a piece of candy cane on either side to create arms.
9. Using the knife to apply icing to the smallest orange to make eyes and a nose. Stick the third piece of candy cane onto the spot for the nose.
10. Now your snowman friend is complete!
