### INSTRUCTIONS

1. Using a brown marker draw a tree onto your construction paper.
2. There are now various options to do this craft. Choose one of the three options below!

#### Option 1

1. Swirl glue all over your tree.
2. Place the popcorn on top of the glue until it's completely covered.
3. Let it dry.
4. Using the paint brush, carefully paint popcorn pieces using pink paint.
5. Let it dry.

#### Option 2

1. Place glue and pink paint onto small plate (separate from each other).
2. Dip popcorn in paint and then glue.
3. Stick the popcorn to your tree to create popcorn cherry blossoms.
4. Let it dry.

#### Option 3

1. Do you a combination of both Options 1 & 2! There is no right or wrong way to do this craft.
