

## **CRAYON DRIP RAIN CLOUDS**

April showers brings... art inspiration! Create a fun crayon drip rain cloud with the family with this multimedia process art activity.

## **SUPPLY LIST**

- ☐ Card Stock or Heavy Paper
- Binder Clips
- 4 Crayons (we used a variety of blues and grey)
- ☐ Cotton Balls

- ☐ Liquid Glue
- ☐ Hair Dryer
- Buttons or Beads for decoration (optional)
- ☐ Yellow or Gold Pipe Cleaner for Lightning (optional)



## **INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Start by unwrapping the crayons from their wrappers.
- 2. Attach the crayons to the top of the card stock with binder clips.
- 3. Place the card stock upright with something underneath like newspaper as the next step can get messy.
- 4. Using the blow dryer, melt the crayons and let the wax drip down the cover stock or experiment with blowing the wax at different angles with the blow dryer to create your desired effect.
- 5. Once the crayons have cooled, use the liquid glue to attach buttons or beads as desired.
- 6. We used a yellow pipe cleaner to create a thunder bolt too! Experiment with different types of media to make your very own rainy day masterpiece.
