

IGLOO PALACE

Build a cozy igloo while staying out of the cold this winter! The secret? Using marshmallows instead of snow bricks! Your igloo will be warm, snug and not even a little bit chilly.

SUPPLY LIST:

- ☐ Large marshmallows
- ☐ White craft glue
- Wood craft sticks (or coffee stir sticks)
- White foam base
- Decorations (greenery, pom-poms, construction paper)



INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Lay down your foam base and decide where your structure will be. Make an outline of your structure with white glue.
- 2. Start placing marshmallows on the line of glue. Let the glue dry.
- 3. Add another layer of glue and another line of marshmallows to your structure.
- 4. Use the wood sticks to support your growing igloo and to create a unique design.
- 5. Once your structure is complete you can add decorations—maybe your igloo is surrounded by trees or is topped by a waving flag!

ADDITIONAL TIPS:

 You can build your igloo structure on any kind of base, but we like white foam best because it looks like snow!
