"This partnership allows us to provide our community with access to this seasonal favourite while the Children's Museum is undergoing major renovations - which for many of the museum's visitors, is a well-loved, family holiday tradition."

Eaton's Santa's Village features fifteen fairytale vignettes depicting various nursery rhyme classics. During the holiday season, the vignettes are festively decorated and come to life as each of the characters' motors is switched on.

Hancheruk expects visitors will be pleasantly surprised to see the handcrafted restoration work done to the former medieval village setting. "The restoration work has made the vignettes transportable, and places the characters in fantastical vignette cases best suited to their individual stories - for example, the Cinderella characters are now housed within a fairytale castle casing."
