

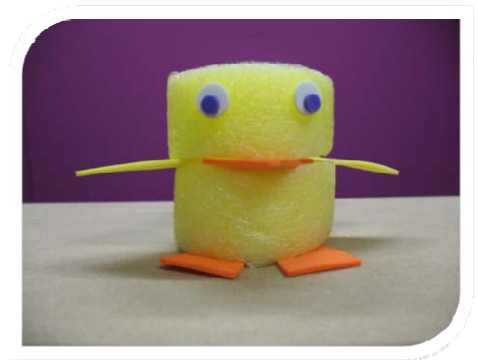
CHILDREN'S MUSEUM FEATURE ACTIVITY

FLOATING FOAM DUCKY

These foam ducks are not only fun to make, they're fun to play with too! Make as many as you want, then have your very own duck race to see which one is the fastest swimmer in the flock.

SUPPLY LIST:

- Yellow pool noodle
- Foam pieces
- Glue
- Scissors



INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Get your pool noodle and cut it into 1 to 2 inch rings. You only need 2 but you can adjust accordingly.
2. Cut out pieces of fun foam to make limbs and facial features then glue to pool noodle rings.
3. Allow glue to dry overnight.
4. Lead your duck to water and watch it float!
