### INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Use a mix of various colours and shapes to prepare an assortment of craft “toppings” to choose from. These can be made from foam pieces, straws, construction paper, tissue paper and more.
2. Cut out yellow construction paper for “cheese” to fit inside paper plate and glue to plate.
3. Cut out bars of brown paper to form surrounding “crust” and glue to plate.
4. Cover your pizza with whichever “toppings” you’d like, gluing them to the plate.
5. Do not cook pizza. Once glue is dry, pizza can be cut into “slices” as desired and served to guests. Buon appetit!
