

CHILDREN'S MUSEUM FEATURE ACTIVITY

IGLOO PALACE

Build a cozy igloo while staying out of the cold this winter! The secret? Using marshmallows instead of snow bricks! Your igloo will be warm, snug and not even a little bit chilly.

SUPPLY LIST:

- Large marshmallows
- White craft glue
- Wood craft sticks (or coffee stir sticks)
- White foam base
- Decorations (greenery, pom-poms, construction paper)



INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Lay down your foam base and decide where your structure will be. Make an outline of your structure with white glue.
2. Start placing marshmallows on the line of glue. Let the glue dry.
3. Add another layer of glue and another line of marshmallows to your structure.
4. Use the wood sticks to support your growing igloo and to create a unique design.
5. Once your structure is complete you can add decorations—maybe your igloo is surrounded by trees or is topped by a waving flag!

ADDITIONAL TIPS:

- You can build your igloo structure on any kind of base, but we like white foam best because it looks like snow!
