

CHILDREN'S MUSEUM FEATURE ACTIVITY

LADYBUG FAN

A colourful ladybug pal to help you stay cool this summer.

SUPPLY LIST:

- Construction paper
- Scissors
- Staples or tape
- Markers
- Ribbon



INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Start with a black piece of construction paper. Attach two rectangles of red construction paper with staples or tape.
2. Cut out some black dots and attach them to the red paper. Cut out some eyes and decorate them however you like!
3. Using black paper, cut out several long, skinny strips for legs. Attach to the outside edges of the paper as shown in the picture.
4. Carefully fold the entire sheet accordion-style from one edge of the paper to the other.
5. Pinch the bottom of the folded paper together. Secure it with a ribbon—you can curl it if you like!
6. Enjoy staying cool all summer long.

ADDITIONAL TIPS:

- Make your ladybug as colourful as you like with different colours of construction paper. Or you can make a classic ladybug by using black and red paper.
