

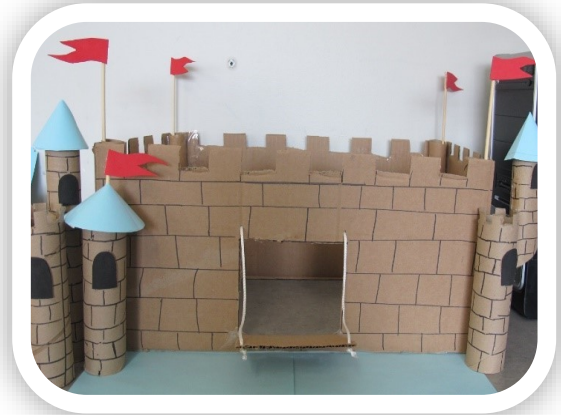

## CARDBOARD CASTLES

### INSTRUCTIONS

1. Look around your house to find a box/boxes, and paper towel rolls to use for your castle.
2. Put your thinking cap on and design your castle! Move the boxes and paper towel rolls around as you test out different designs.
3. Once you've found something you're happy with, it's time to attach it together. Use either tape or hot glue for this step. If you're using a hot glue gun, be sure to be extra careful!
4. Once your castle is attached, you can use markers, foam shapes, and construction paper to decorate! Try drawing on the bricks for your castle, creating windows out of foam shapes, turrets out of construction paper, or use dowels to help create towering flag posts!
5. Use scissors to carefully cut designs into your castle or to create a door.
