

COVID-19 GUIDELINES



The following guidelines are currently in effect at the Children's Museum:

Staff, volunteers, contractors, vendors, and guests must use the self-screening tool before entering the facility: <https://sharedhealthmb.ca/covid19/screening-tool/>

DO NOT ENTER THE MUSEUM IF:

- You are ill or experiencing COVID-like symptoms.

PHYSICAL DISTANCING & SAFETY PROTOCOLS

- Maintain two meters (6 feet) of physical distance between other individuals and/or groups at all times.
- Physical distancing protocols will be enforced. See floor markings for designated **Waiting Zones** and **Play Zones** that meet physical distancing requirements.
- Modifications have been made to some galleries and exhibits to ensure physical distancing requirements are met. These modifications may change; please consult childrensmuseum.com or an Admissions Attendant for a complete list of modifications prior to purchasing your general admission.
- Guests must sanitize hands upon entry to facility. Hand sanitizer is available at the entrance/exit and in other areas for guest use.
- Observe provincially-recommended hygiene practices for handwashing, hand sanitizing, and coughing/sneezing.
- Personal protective equipment and other protective measures may be in use by staff and volunteers, including: physical barriers, non-medical face masks, gloves, face shields, and other items.
- Facility, including washrooms, are subject to enhanced sanitization frequency and measures.
- Guests will be provided a *Cleaning Supply Basket* to aid in additional sanitization of individual areas throughout their visit.
- Occupancy levels have been reduced to allow a maximum of 50 guests in the facility at a given time. (Note: This number may change as guidelines surrounding the size of indoor gatherings are updated.)
- The use of non-medical face masks is **REQUIRED** by all visitors and staff members (ages 5 and up) within the facility's public and communal spaces.
- Cashless or no-contact payment should be used to the greatest extent possible.
