

COVID-19 GUIDELINES

DURING YOUR VISIT

- The use of non-medical face masks is optional, but encouraged and appreciated.
- Physical distancing is encouraged. Please maintain two meters (6 feet) of physical distance between other individuals and/or groups.
- Capacity levels have been reduced.
- Guests are encouraged to sanitize hands upon entry to facility. Hand sanitizer is available at the entrance/exit and in other areas for guest use.
- Observe provincially-recommended hygiene practices for handwashing, hand sanitizing, and coughing/sneezing.
- Personal protective equipment and other protective measures may be in use by staff and volunteers, including: physical barriers, non-medical face masks, gloves, face shields, and other items.
- Facility is subject to enhanced sanitization frequency and measures. Some galleries may be closed periodically for 15-30-minute intervals to allow for enhanced cleaning.
- High-touch and/or hard-to-clean manipulatives (i.e., loose toys, costumes, etc) have been removed from some galleries.
- Water fountains are turned off. Drinking water is available upon request at the Admissions Desk.
- Cashless or no-contact payment should be used to the greatest extent possible.
- Admission is available on a first-come, first-served basis. Admission is valid all day – however, visitors wishing to re-enter the museum may need to wait in line if the maximum capacity has been reached.
